Utilizes gameplay to **help women stack their skills and accelerate success** through a global network of corporate leadership development workshops and lessons.

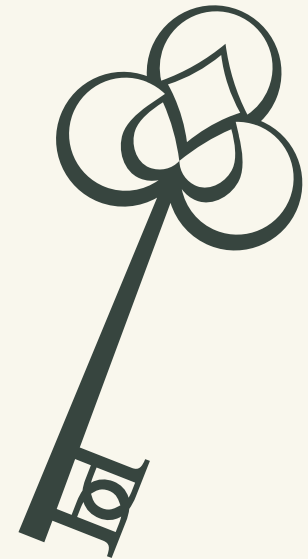
By empowering women with key skills, **we are changing the future for generations to come.**

## Our curriculum and programs

- ▶ **Virtual, IRL, hybrid and on-demand** available
- ▶ **Kickoff events**; 12 poker lessons; culminating tournaments
- ▶ **Unique gamified leadership lessons** tied to key professional development themes including risk taking, courage, capital allocation, resilience and strategic decision making
- ▶ **60 minute Zoom sessions** led by live female teachers. Includes 30 minutes of interactive gameplay on our proprietary teaching poker app
- ▶ **90 minute IRL workshops** includes keynote, poker 101 and one teacher for every 10 attendees for 60 minutes of interactive gameplay
- ▶ **Poker Power Play app** is the hub of our community and where we learn and play each day



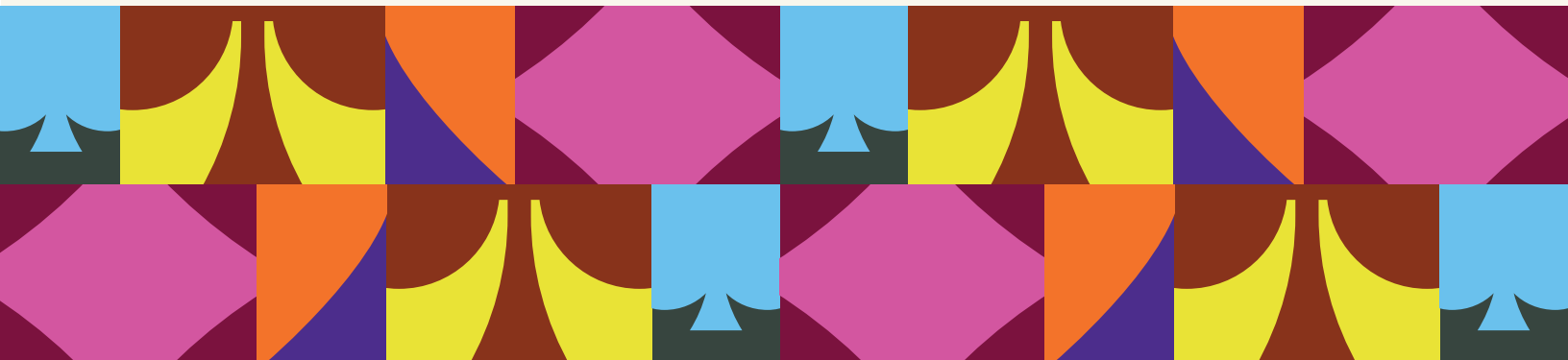
## A few case examples
